It is the intention of The Manor School to supervise an activity program for all interested, committed students who consistently abide by the rules and regulations herein stated as well as those verbally stated by the Directors, Coaches, Sports Director and Headmistress. It is also the intention of the School to establish a cooperative relationship with parents of student participants so that all persons involved have clear understandings of what is expected. It is the intention of the School's Activity Program to develop individual and team spirit and cooperation; develop an appreciation for and enjoyment of enrichment activities, individual and team sports; develop sportsmanship, personal skills, self control, respect for adults and peers, a strong sense of commitment, and knowledge of game and activity rules. With these points in mind, specific expectations are as follows:

1. Members must attend all scheduled meetings, sessions, practices, games, and performances, or bring a valid written note from a parent.
2. Members know that unexcused absences from practices and/or games/performances will result in being restricted from participation and, if excessive, being expelled from the activity and possible further participation in the program.
3. Members must complete the activity season or bring a valid medical note.
4. Members must have satisfactory grades. If satisfactory grades are not maintained, members must attend tutorial sessions with the teachers of the courses with unsatisfactory grades at times convenient with teachers, even if this conflicts with scheduled sessions, games or performances. If a member attends a mandatory tutorial session, the respective teacher will sign a note to the adult in charge of the activity which excuses the player from the session or partial session.
5. Members must bring practice clothing and/or supplies to school, change if needed immediately after school dismissal, and go straight to the session.
6. Members must provide their own transportation from sessions, practices, performances, games. School transportation will be used to sessions if off-campus. Students may be transported by other team members ONLY with permission from both the driver's and passenger's parents, the Coach AND Mrs. Gadd.
7. Members must abide by school and activity rules, Director's/Coach's directions, any governing body regulations, judges', referees', and umpires' decisions.
8. Members are to contact Mrs. Gadd, and individual Directors/Coaches when there are problems or questions. Joint decisions will be made by this group when needed.
