

## Art Homework -- 9th Grade

### Sept. 19th

Draw three polyhedrons. Place one polyhedron in the background. Place one polyhedron in the foreground, and one in the middle ground. Don't forget that things in the front are bigger and overlap the things that are in the back. **Do Not Color. Shade. OVERLAPPING / CAST SHADOW / CORE OF THE SHADOW / HIGHLIGHT / SIZE / PLACEMENT**

### October 3rd

Draw one building showing three sides. Add details to the drawing to show where the building is and what it is used for. Use your whole paper. Draw in black, white, and three greys. **DETAIL / COMPOSITION / IMAGINATION**

### October 17th

Draw a chair from an unusual point of view. **DRAW IT LARGE SCALE. SHADE** it realistically using **GRADATION**. Consider highlights, shadows, cast shadows, and core of the shadow. If you do not remember these from last year, ask!

### Nov 7th

Draw something from your room that has good positive and negative space/shapes. Color the negative shapes/spaces orange and the positive shapes/spaces blue. Gradate all the shapes/spaces. Use your creativity. **NEGATIVE SHAPES / GRADATION / TINTS / SHADES**

### Nov 21st

Draw a self-portrait. Look in the mirror. Do not draw it from a picture. Remember how to divide the shape of the face up from last year. If you do not, ask! Put in the shadows and cast shadows and core of the shadows. **SHADE / PROPORTION / DETAIL**

### Dec. 5th

Draw something that reminds you of Christmas in a 5" X 7" rectangle. Color the entire space. **OVERLAP / BLEND / GRADATE**

### Dec 19th

Draw a coconut tree. Draw and color it to seem joyful and peaceful. Use an analogous color scheme. Add only one other thing in your picture to complete it. Think about what that one thing should be and how it should be placed in your picture. **COLOR SCHEMES FOR EMOTION / SYMBOLISM**

### Jan 16th

**TRACE** the same coconut tree. Draw and color it to look lonely. Use a monochromatic color scheme. Add a different thing to complete it. **COLOR SCHEMES FOR EMOTION / SYMBOLISM**

### Jan 30th

Your choice. **Make it GOOD!** Use your whole piece of paper drawing a background and a foreground. Use any medium you want. And make sure you **USE ALL OF THE BOLD FACED WORDS ABOVE!**
