

Manor School Student Dress Code 2010-2011

FEMALES: Kindergarten-Grade 12

Official "Manor Plaid" skirt WITH sleeveless vest, or one-piece jumper (styles may vary; straps without a bib are NOT acceptable) and a short or long-sleeved white, collared uniform or polo shirt, or navy blue ankle-length, non-jeans type/style slacks with a uniform blouse and "Manor Plaid" vest or an official Manor polo or T-shirt; sheer knee or regular navy, black, gray or white socks (NOT sports socks) or hose; navy, black, gray or white closed-toed or slightly open dressy heeled, non-sneaker type shoes are the components of the Manor uniform. Vests are to remain ON while in uniform. For Kindergarten through Grade 6 ONLY, knee-length pants (not gym or sports shorts) may be worn with Manor polo or T-shirt, or blouse and vest. Skirts and jumpers may be no shorter than, nor have slits that open above, the tops of knee-caps. Manor collarless T-shirts or shirts may NOT be worn with skirts or jumpers. Shirrtails are to be tucked in at all times while on campus or at school activities. Manor Plaid is on sale ONLY at Uniform City.

MALES: Elementary--Kindergarten-Grade 6

Navy blue non-jean type/style slacks or knee-length pants (not gym or sports shorts), short or long-sleeved white, collared uniform or polo shirt, or official Manor School polo or T-shirt; navy, black, gray or white socks (NOT sports socks); and navy, black, gray, or white closed-toed, non-sneaker type shoes are the components of the Manor uniform. Slacks must be worn close enough to the waistline so no under-clothing or inappropriate outlines of body parts are visible, and shirrtails are to be tucked in at all times while on campus or at school activities.

MALES: Upper School--Grades 7-12

Navy blue non-jeans type/style slacks, short or long-sleeved white, collared uniform or polo shirt (no emblems), or official Manor School polo or T-shirt; navy, black, gray, or white socks (NOT sports socks); and navy, black, gray, or white closed-toed, non-sneaker type shoes are the components of the Manor uniform. Faces are to be clean shaven and hairstyles neat, clean, trimmed and representative of the traditional image of The Manor School. Slacks are to be worn close enough to the waistline so no under-clothing or inappropriate outlines of body parts are visible, and shirrtails are to be tucked in at all times while on campus or at school activities.

ALL STUDENTS

Hairstyles are to be neat, clean, trimmed and representative of the traditional image of The Manor School. No hats, caps, visors, du-rags, bandanas, head coverings or curlers; when confiscated, they will NOT be returned. Jewelry is always to be in moderation, of appropriate size and emblems. Navy blue, black, white or gray belts must be worn with slacks that have belt loops. Manor team shirts may be worn only by team members. Shirrtails must be tucked in at all times. No sunglasses. The Dress Code is in force as long as a student is on campus or at a function requiring the uniform. The Dress Code does NOT end when classes are dismissed.

ALL STUDENTS--Non Acceptable Dress Code Items

Jeans by style or material, pants any color other than navy blue, shirts with non-Manor or inappropriate emblems or messages, colored shirts under uniform shirts, shirrtails out, pants too low, sandals, flip-flops, slippers, sunglasses, sneakers, sneaker-type shoes, or any sports shoes, as well as caps, hats, visors, du-rags, bandanas, head coverings or curlers are NOT acceptable Manor Dress Code items.

ALL STUDENTS and PARENTS

Agreeing to follow The Manor Dress Code is a part of the Manor enrollment process and the commitment of Students AND Parents each school day. Any Student not in proper uniform will be sent to the Office to call to have a Parent bring proper uniform items or serve in-school suspension, lose Colored Clothes, and/or serve Work Detail on designated days. Teachers vote on Friday's Colored Clothes Day each Thursday, and Students are informed if they have retained or lost the privilege. If a Student is absent on Thursday, he/she must call the Office for the voting result. Appropriate clothing is required on Colored Clothes Days as well, being especially mind-ful of items too short or too revealing. No halter, tube, tank (male or female), thin or one-shoulder strap tops, or any tops that reveal cleavage; no clothing shorter than knee caps; no visible mid-body flesh; no flip flops, slippers, sun-glasses, caps, hats, visors, du-rags, bandanas, head coverings or curlers. Use good judgment. Nothing inappropriate is to be worn. Students are to be checked on a daily basis by Parents before leaving for school.
