2010-11 Supply List for Grades 1-12

All Students, label all personal items.

ELEMENTARY

1 small, separate Homework Assignment Book (customized type available in the Office); 3 small Manor notebooks or small non-spiral bound notebooks; 1 three-ring binder with minimum of 7 each of dividers and pocket folders; six #2 pencils in pencil box or bag; 1 eraser; 1 package of markers; 1 set of colored pencils; 1 pair of scissors; 1 ruler with inch and metric markings; 1 hand-held pencil sharpener; 1 highlighter; 1 bottle of correction fluid; 2 blue or black pens; water resistant book covers for all books; poster boards, construction paper, an appropriate Free Reading Book; 1 box facial tissues; 1 large, old shirt for Art projects; a labeled container for water; P. E. clothes and sneakers.

Lunch/Snack--A daily nutritious snack is provided by the school. Lunch may be ordered from the school program or brought from home. Water is available to fill individual bottles. Drinks from home must be 100% juice. NO teas, sodas, cookies, or candy, even after school.

P.E. GRADES 1-8

Manor T-shirt, white or blue shorts, sneakers, socks, labeled water bottle or thermos, sunscreen, visor or cap (only worn at the Park; kept in book bag ALL other times).

ART, GRADES 1-12

Each student is responsible for the purchase and proper use and maintenance of art supplies, and for replacement of those abused or lost. Each art student **MUST** have a large, old shirt for daily Art projects, Art Pad, looseleaf paper, a subject folder, and daily pencil supply.

GRADES 7-12

1 small, separate Homework Assignment Book (customized type available in the Office); 1 three ring binder with minimum of 7 each of dividers and pocket folders; abundant supply of looseleaf paper; 1 pack of graph paper; 4 large sewn-bound notebooks; six #2 pencils in a pencil box or bag; 3 blue or black pens; 1 eraser; 2 highlighters; 1 ruler with inch and metric markings; labeled Texas Instrument Calculator TI-83, 84, or 84 Plus; Art Pad; construction paper pad; 1 large, old shirt for Art projects; water resistant book covers for all books; an appropriate Free Reading Book; labeled container for water; 1 folder for HW; large back pack or wheeled bag.
